Update on Pre-travel testing for China

The requirement

<u>From 10/12/20</u> people travelling to China can have either two PCR tests on consecutive days or a single PCR test and an IgM blood test, which can be performed in a single appointment.

<u>From 18/12/20</u> it will be compulsory for people to have the single PCR test and IgM blood test. The two PCR tests will no longer be accepted.

These tests need to be performed within two days of travel. Testing kits will be provided by the CHL lab. As usual, if you are planning to offer this service, you will be respponsible for notifying test results in the required format. You will need to charge the patient for the cost of both tests and any additional costs incurred by your practice. The lab will invoice you for the cost of the tests (see below).

Children under 5 years old, travelling with an adult, do not need to be tested.

We are waiting for a formal process to be put in place by the Ministry of Health around managing a positive IgM result. We hope this will be available before 18/12/20.

Lab Options

CHL are expected to have the IgM test available from Tuesday 15 December at a cost of \$70+gst. Attached is a document with the process to follow. (Labs will continue to charge \$80+gst for the PCR swab test).

CSCL will also be processing PCR tests and IgM blood tests for pre-travel to China only. Their process and fees are available here (https://www.canterburyscl.co.nz/blog/2020/12/04/pre-departure-testing-for-travel-to-china/) and in the attached document.

CSCL will not be processing results on Sundays or Public holidays without prior agreement. Please keep this in mind when booking people for tests. Their on-call microbiologist can be contacted on 027 550 7034. Please follow their process carefully.

Timeframes

These pre-travel tests for China need to be performed within two days of travel. If you are unable to complete all requirements within the required timeframes please refer your patient. The following designated practices are still able to see people for this service (by appointment only):

- Moorhouse Medical Centre
- Riccarton Clinic
- We Care Health Wigram.

This process will be updated on HealthPathways.
